The Company may discontinue certain Company services in geographic areas for which the Company has no customers subscribing to those services.

In addition and subject to the appropriate regulatory approvals, the Company may grandfather or discontinue all services governed by this Tariff in certain geographic areas. Once grandfathered such services will no longer be available for purchase, and existing customers will no longer be able to move, add or change their existing service.⁽²⁾
