Descriptive Narrative:	<p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T South Carolina (AT&T South Carolina) intends to retire copper feeder and distribution facilities serving Distribution Areas (DAs) 413002 and 413003 in the Boiling Springs wire center (SPBGSCBS) in Boiling Springs, SC due to planned road and construction work along Old Furnace Road and Old Belcher Road, and has been requested to remove or relocate any of its facilities that may be impacted by or conflict with this project by March 27, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T South Carolina (AT&T South Carolina) intends to retire copper feeder facilities in Distribution Area (DA) 423009 within the Greer Wire Center (GRERSCMA) in Greer, SC. This work aligns with the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) road-widening project on Suber Rd at Chick Springs Rd (Project P041423) and includes removing or relocating facilities that conflict with construction. The planned off-network date is March 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications LLC d/b/a AT&T South Carolina (AT&T South Carolina) intends to retire copper facilities in Distribution Area (DA) 141004 within the Deer Park wire center (CHTNSCDP) in Goose Creek, SC due to damaged cable at Stephanie Dr (SAI—damaged). The affected legacy services cannot be reliably repaired using copper; any temporary measures in place remain subject to ongoing risk. No copper replacement is planned once customer migration is complete.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T South Carolina (AT&T South Carolina) intends to retire the copper feeder facilities serving DA 141505 in the Deer Park Wire Center (CHTNSCDP) Goose Creek, SC due to damage from a vehicle accident at 100 Montague Plantation Blvd. that crushed the VRAD and degraded the copper plant. Temporary repairs are in place to maintain service, but permanent restoration would require full replacement. AT&T South Carolina does not plan to replace the copper facilities; they will be retired after customer migrations are complete.</p>

AT&T South Carolina has been requested to remove or relocate its facilities that may be in the way of this project by March 19,2026</p> <p>AT&T South Carolina plans to migrate customers served by copper facilities to existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) facilities and then retire the copper facilities.</p>
