



A12.7.2 Rates And Charges



- Note 1: The installation charge in A12.7.2.A.1.(a) applies for the establishment of the first group of Non-Consecutive DID numbers where the customer does not currently have DID service. It also applies for the first group of Reserved Numbers or the first Reserved Non-Consecutive DID number where the customer does not currently have DID service or Non-Consecutive DID numbers.
- **Note 2:** In addition to the rates and charges for the DID Trunk Termination, rates and charges for DID PBX Trunks or NARs as specified in Section A3 apply as appropriate.
- **Note 3:** Combination DID Trunk Terminations with the Call Transfer feature are only provisioned where facilities permit.
- **Note 4:** Provides faster signaling on DID PBX trunks or NARs. The choice of pulsing alternative depends on the customer's premises equipment.

This service enables a customer, by means of an operator, to restrict outgoing foll calls from station line users to certain types of calls such as those which pre-charged to the called number or a third number.
- C. Terms and Conditions
 - . Connections will not be established between a toll trunk and exchange station lines of other toll trunks in the exchange area where the toll trunk is located.
 - 2. Toll trunks are furnished only to customers who have local exchange service concurrently. Also, all local calls and calls to certain Company numbers such as repair service, Public Emergency Service (911), etc. will be permitted from the customer's establishment only on regular exchange service facilities of the customer.
 - 3. Outward connections only will be established from a toll trunk.
 - 4. Service arrangements, requested by the customer, in excess of the intent of this guidebook may be provided at charges based on cost.
 - 5. This service is furnished only where facilities permit.

 - 5. Customers may subscribe to either the standalone BellSouth Business Plus service offering or to the Complete Choice for Business Package (See A3.45) which includes a BellSouth Business Plus service line. If BellSouth Business Plus service is subscribed to, the rates of A3.43.2 are applicable. If Complete Choice for Business package is subscribed to the rates of A3.45.2 are applicable. All of the terms, conditions and limitations specified for each offering will apply to the respective services and features.
 - 6. Usage rating is dependent upon the underlying service of the originating call location. When BellSouth Business Plus service usage charges as described in paragraph 2 are applicable, they will also apply to 1+, 0+ and 0- calls made within the LATA. However, for 0+ and 0- calls, usage does not contribute toward the Option 1 usage threshold and each minute of use is rated. The appropriate operator services surcharges will also be charged in accordance with the terms and conditions of A.3.14.
 - 7. BellSouth Business Plus service Option 2 customers only may subscribe to Local Usage Detail for billable usage. There is no charge for the Local Usage Detail.



- A. Warm Line Service provides a business customer who has basic exchange line service with a time delayed automatic dialing capability. If the customer with this service goes off-hook and initiates dialing within the time delay period, the call will proceed normally as dialed. If dialing does not commence within the time delay period (0-20 seconds), a preprogrammed number is automatically dialed. The preprogrammed number and time-delay period are selected by the customer at the time service is established and can be changed only via service order.
- Warm Line Service may be used only in connection with individual line service.
- Warm Line Service is furnished only from central offices which have been arranged to provide this service and is provided subject to the availability of facilities.
