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A 107.4 Access Line Service For Custom er-Provided Public Telephones

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Obsoleted June 1, 2021; Type D . Beginning June 1, 2021, new orders for this service will no longer be accepted. Current subscribers may keep their service at its existing location. The Company currently plans to discontinue this service on orafter June 1, 2025.

A 107.4.1 Definition And Requirements

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A coess line service for custom errowned coin operated telephone (COCOT) is an exchange line service provided at the request of a subscriber for telecom munications use by the general public. This access line service is not available without an authorization number issued by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA). The term COCOT is used interchangeably within this Guidebook and in the TRA Rules and Regulations with Public Pay Telephone Service provided by an owner or operator who is not a public company certified by the TRA.

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A. Every company or individual, who is not a public telephone company certified by the TRA in accordance with TCA 65-4-201, operating a public pay telephone instrument located in the state of Tennessee connected with or to be connected with the public network shall be authorized by the TRA to provide pay telephone service in accordance with Rules in Chapter 1220-4-2. Customer-provided public pay telephone service shall mean the resale of local service and/or intrastate toll telephone service through customer or telephone company provided equipment which is coin operated or coinless and whose calls are sentpaid or non-sentpaid.

In order to insure uniformity throughout the state with regard to the provision of pay telephone service to the public, the owner or operator of a public pay telephone service seeking authorization to operate a pay telephone service shall agree to abide by the Rules of the TRA as outlined in Chapter 1220-4-2 including, but not limited to the following:

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- 1. The following calls shall be provided without depositing money and free of charge to the customer: calls to the Company's operator; 911 or emergency numbers; toll-free and 800 service numbers; pay phone repair and refund numbers; and interexchange access numbers.

2. Local call charges are m arketbased.

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3. The public pay telephone shall provide the following: two way calling capability (unless waived by the TRA); no time limits on calls; the acceptance of nickels, dimes and quarters; and coin return for incomplete calls (coinless phones shall not be required to accept coins).

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4. All public pay telephone instruments installed after July 1,1990 shall be installed in accordance with the requirements of the American National Standards Institute for Buildings and Facilities - Providing Accessibility and Usability for Physically Handicapped People, ANSI, A 1171 (1986), Section 429, Telephones. Provided, however, that in a given location where an owner has installed more than one instrument, only one pay telephone instrument shall be required to meet those requirements.

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- 5. All public pay telephone instruments shall comply with TRA approved telecommunications industry standards and the currentNational Electric Code.
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6. Local telephone directories shall be provided at each pay telephone service location.

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7. The owner shall read and comply with all TRA rules and regulations governing public pay telephone service.
8. The owner shall charge for intrastate toll calls, including operator assistance surcharges, no more than the rates approved

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by the TRA for the Company and the dominant interexchange carrier in the state.

9. The owner shall provide an instrument capable of completing local and long distance calls. Provided however, that a coinless pay telephone is exempt from this requirement as long as the instrument is located in close proximity or next to

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a pay phone with local and long distance calling capabilities.

10. The owner agrees to provide custom er access to all interexchange carriers certificated to do business in Tennessee in the interexchange carriers preferred manner as officially designated by said carrier to the TRA.

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Note 1: Pursuant to the Federal Communication Commission's Report and Order, Order on Reconsideration and Request for Clarification of Effective Date of Compensation for Directory Assistance Calls in CC Docket No. 96-128, the local coin rate and directory assistance rate charged to end users is market based as of October 7, 1997.

The public pay telephone service may only be connected to access line service for custom exprovided public telephones (O) as provided herein. It must be served on a single public telephone access line directly connected to the Company's network and billed at the quidebook rate. 12. Installation, maintenance and operation of the public telephone instrument is the responsibility of the owner. Timely (0) repairs shall be performed on the instruments by the owner; access lines are the responsibility of the Company. 13. For custom ers subscribing to Caller ID - Deluxe, as specified in paragraph A 13 19 2 H, if the incoming call originates (0) from a custom er provided public pay telephone instrum ent, the name information transmitted will always be "Pay Phone".
