

<u>Re: Application of AT&T Texas to Increase Rates for Residential Local Exchange Telephone</u> Service in PURA Chapter 58 Regulated Exchanges

Dear Filing Clerk:

Pursuant to Findings of Fact Nos. 19 and 24 in the Commission's Order in Docket No. 40521¹ and Article V of the Stipulation and Agreement approved in that docket, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Texas hereby applies to increase its monthly rates by \$2.00 for residential local exchange telephone service in Public Utility Regulatory Act Chapter 58 regulated exchanges. Those exchanges are listed in Attachment A. AT&T Texas proposes to increase monthly Lifeline rates in these exchanges by \$1.50, consistent with Finding of Fact No. 26 in the Order. Consistent with the Stipulation and Agreement, AT&T Texas requests that this application be approved effective January 3, 2014.

Pursuant to Proc. Rule 22.55, AT&T Texas proposes to provide the notice set forth in Attachment B to all affected residential customers in bill messages beginning December 6, 2013. A copy of the proposed notice was given to Commission Staff in advance for review. AT&T Texas' proposed tariff sheets are set forth in Attachment C.

Pursuant to Proc. Rule 22.71(c)(1), AT&T Texas hereby files an original and nine copies of this application. Please acknowledge receipt thereof by returning a file-stamped copy to me. The rates shown below apply to all exchanges except those listed on sheet 4.1 and are the net Lifeline Discount Telephone Service local exchange access service rates after the appropriate Lifeline reduction has been applied to the regular monthly local exchange access service line rate for each applicable residential grade of service as shown in 3.1.1(A), preceding. The rate for qualified Tribal Lands Applicants, defined as those low-income consumers who live on a reservation as specified in 3.1.1(C)(2)(D) of this tariff, may not be reduced below \$1.{6}
