SUSPENSION AND RESTORAL OF SERVICE

1. Suspension of Service - Initiated by SWBT (Cont'd)

1.5 Unless a dangerous condition exists or unless the customer requests disconnection, service will not be disconnected on a day, or on a day immediately preceding a day, when SWBT personnel are not available to the public for the purpose of making collections and reconnecting service.

2. Restoral of Service - Initiated by SWBT

2.1 A Restoration Charge for each local exchange or Wide Area Telecommunications Service (WATS) access line suspended will apply for restoring service after its suspension by SWBT. The charge is as follows:

Restoration Charge:

Residence - \$35.00

(I)

Business - \$25.00

In addition to the Restoration Charge, the customer will be required to pay all charges due, including the charges for the period of denial.

2.2 This Restoration Charge applies only for the restoral of suspended service initiated by SWBT.

2.3 In accordance with 26.29 (e) (1) (B) (ii) of the Commission's Substantive Rules, the Restoration Charge will be deferred for customers subscribing to Prepaid Local Telephone Service (PLTS), as outlined in Section 1 of the Local Exchange Tariff 3.1.1(D), until such time as the subscribing customer leaves PLTS to return to basic local telecommunications service.

3. Suspension of Service - Initiated by the Customer ("Vacation Service") {1}

3.1 Suspension of Service is available for a period of one month or more to customers for any grade of business or residence service. Neither outward nor inward calling is provided during periods of suspension.
