#### DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE

### 1. General

- 1.1 The Company furnishes Directory Assistance Service whereby customers may request assistance in determining local and intraLATA directory information. National Directory Assistance information may be found in Section 21 of this tariff. Directory Assistance Listing Information provided is from Company's Directory Assistance records, other companies, and in some circumstances specific numbers provided by a Business Customer or its representative.
- 1.2 The rates set forth below apply to calls from customers whose requests for local or intraLATA directory information are provided by the Company and billed to its subscribers.

### 2. Directory Assistance

### 2.1 Regulations

- 2.13 Customers may make two listing requests per call at no additional (E) charge. Each additional listing request after the 1st two is \$2.09 each. There is a maximum of ten requests per call. (I) Customers desiring more than one listing per call should inform the Directory Assistance operator at the beginning of the call.
- 2.14 Where the customer places a call to the Directory Assistance attendant via an operator or has Directory Assistance charges billed to a telephone calling card, or a telephone number other than the originating number, the call shall be considered alternately billed. If dial facilities are not available, calls placed to Directory Assistance via an operator shall be considered as Customer dialed.

### Directory Assistance (cont'd)

### 2.1 Regulations (cont'd)

- 2.15 No credit will be given for requested telephone numbers that are nonpublished or nonlisted. No credit will be given for requested telephone numbers that are not found in the directory.
- 2.16 Charges for Directory Assistance Service are not applicable to calls placed from Hospitals, or from Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service as provided for in the Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service Tariff (Section 36) of the General Exchange Tariff. However, an end user may alternatively bill Directory Assistance from pay telephones to a calling card or a telephone number other than the originating number as specified in the Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service Tariff.
- 2.17 Customers whose physical or visual disabilities prevent them from using the telephone directory are also excluded from charging upon presentation of a certificate signed by any physician or issued by any agency recognized by the state as having the authority to certify such handicaps. Customers will be provided instructions for convenient use when they are not at their primary residence.
- 2.18 Calls placed from Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service will be given a maximum of two requests per call.

### 28. National Directory Assistance Service

### 28.1 Service Description

National Directory Assistance (National DA) is a service whereby customers may request assistance in determining listing information on a nationwide basis. Requests for local or intraLATA listings are billed under the Directory Assistance charges as described in Section 11 of the General Exchange Tariff.

### 28.2 General Regulations

The regulations and rates set forth below apply to all calls from customers who request assistance in determining telephone number information of subscribers who are located outside their LATA.

- 28.2.1 The customer will be charged for each call; customers may request up to two (2) listings per call. Customers desiring more than one listing should inform the Directory Assistance operator at the beginning of the call that they want multiple listings. The National DA rate applies per call whether or not a number is provided; this includes requests for numbers which are non-published or non-listed.
- 28.2.2 There are no billing exemptions or allowances for National DA service requests.
- 28.2.3 National Directory Assistance will not be available from Hotel/Motel and Pay Telephones.
