3. PLEXAR-II (Cont'd)

3.4 Rules and Regulations (Cont'd)

3.4.18 PLEXAR-II stations shall have available the calling scope associated with the Plexar serving central office as defined in the Local Exchange Tariff.

3.4.19 All Plexar-II stations included in a multi-location serving arrangement will be furnished the same calling scope.

3.4.20 Reserved

3.4.21 Features with Call Forwarding/Transfer capabilities cannot be used on a continual basis to expand the local calling scope of any incoming calls originated from any party outside the Plexar-II service arrangement.

3.4.22 Call management features are comprised of a group of features which permit customers to efficiently manage the call flow generated over their Local Exchange Access Lines. This management is possible only where the calling party's telephone number is sent from the central office originating the call to the terminating central office serving the called party.

3.4.23 Any SWBT calling party, whether they subscribe to Caller ID services or not, may prevent the delivery of Calling Party Name and/or Number (CPN) to the called party by dialing an access code (*67 on their touch-tone pad or 1167 from a rotary telephone) immediately prior to placing a call. The access code activates per call blocking. Per call blocking is available at no charge.

3.4.24 If a calling party activates blocking, the CPN will not be transmitted across the station line, including calls within and outside the Plexar group. Instead, Calling Name and/or Number Delivery (CND) subscribers will receive an anonymous indicator. This anonymous indicator notifies the CND subscriber that the calling party chose to block number delivery.

3.4.25 Per-line blocking will be offered at no charge to a particular customer if the Commission receives from the customer written certification that the customer has a compelling need for per-line blocking.

3.4.26 The blocking of CPN will not be provided on calls originating from Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service.

3.4.27 CND service is offered on a subscription basis which requires the customer to order the service. Where CND service is available, any calling party, whether they subscribe to CND or not, has per call blocking capability, unless that customer is calling from a Pay Telephone Exchange Access Service.

3.4.28 SWBT shall not be liable for any and all claims for damages caused or claimed to have been caused, directly or indirectly, by the transmission to a CND customer of a telephone number which the calling party has requested to be omitted from the telephone directory or the disclosing of such telephone number to any person.

3.4.29 SWBT shall not be liable for any and all claims for damages caused by a telecommunications utility failure to transmit the privacy indicator to the called party when such indicator has been passed to the telecommunication utility by SWBT.

CALL MANAGEMENT SERVICES

3. EasyOptions® Services - Features (Cont'd)

3.2 Call Forwarding

Enables the customer to transfer all incoming calls to another telephone number within the exchange or on the Long Distance Telecommunications Network. The Call Forwarding customer is responsible for the payment of charges (e.g., toll charges) for each call between his Call Forwarding equipped telephone and the telephone to which the call is being forwarded. The transmission may not meet normal standards depending on the distance and the routing necessary. Call Forwarding and the Selective Call Forwarding service can be activated at the same time except in 1A switches.

Call Forwarding is offered for use with two-way PBX trunks subject to the following limitations:

(A) May be provided when compatible with the equipment configuration at the customer's premises.

(B) Available only in certain types of central offices.

(C) Available only with two types of hunting arrangements, multiline and series completion, and subject to the limitations of these hunting arrangements.

3.3 Selective Call Forwarding

Provides the customer with the ability to forward incoming calls from preselected telephone numbers to another telephone number. The customer may construct or modify a telephone number screening list. SWBT's equipment will screen incoming calls against the customer's list and forward only those calls from telephone numbers on the list. The maximum amount of telephone numbers available for each customer's list may vary depending on switch type. The Selective Call Forwarding customer is responsible for the payment of charges (e.g., toll charges) for each call between the Selective Call Forwarding equipped telephone line and the line to which the call is being forwarded. Calls from numbers not on the list will receive standard call completion. Selective Call Forwarding and the Call Forwarding service may be activated at the same time except in 1A switches.

3.4 Simultaneous Call Forwarding

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Provides the customer that also subscribes to an appropriate call forwarding service with the ability to forward multiple incoming calls simultaneously to another telephone number designated by the customer. The Simultaneous call Forwarding customer must subscribe to sufficient facilities to adequately handle calls without impairing any services offered by SWBT. The Simultaneous Call Forwarding customer is responsible for the payment of charges (e.g., toll charges) for each call between the Simultaneous Call Forwarding equipped telephone line and the line to which the call is being forwarded.

11. Residence Personality Logo

11.1 General

- 11.1.1 A residence Personality Logosm listing allows a residence customer to add a logo to a primary or an extra listing and enclose that listing in a box frame. The customer will choose from a list of logos prepared by the Company. Such choice is limited to the Company's list. A list of approved logos is available to customers upon request. (T)

- 11.1.3 Personality Logo listings are not intended for use as business advertising and are not available for purchase as business listings. (T)

When a Personality Logo listing is purchased in any of these combinations, the monthly rate for the Personality Logo listing is discounted. DIRECTORY LISTINGS

11. Residence Line of Distinction

11.1 General

11.1.1 A residence Line of DistinctionSM listing permits a customer to add a customized extra line of information to a primary or extra listing in order to further describe the customer. The extra line of information is limited to 34 characters, including spaces, and must meet company established guidelines for acceptability. The extra line appears in italicized type directly below the associated alphabetical listing and above the listed address and telephone number.

11.1.2 Each Line of Distinction listing must be reviewed for acceptability. Determinations of acceptability shall be made solely by the Company and shall be final and binding to the customer. The Company does not guarantee nor does it represent or agree that this review process will be completed prior to the directory close date or otherwise in sufficient time for actual directory print of the listing.

11.1.3 The Line of Distinction listing is not intended to replace the Extra Lines Listing described in section 4.2 of this tariff. Supplemental address information or phrases required to properly direct calls (such as, "Call after 5:00") can be included in the directory through the purchase of Extra Lines.

11.1.4 The Line of Distinction listing is not intended for use as business advertising. Determinations of acceptability shall be made solely by the Company and shall be final and binding to the customer. Line of Distinction listing is not available for purchase for business listings.

11.1.5 The Line of Distinction listing is available singly, in conjunction with a Signature or Personality Logo listing, or in a combination of all three services. When a Line of Distinction listing is purchased in conjunction with a Personality Logo listing or with both a Personality Logo and a Signature Listing, the monthly rate associated with the Personality Logo listing is discounted. When only the Signature Listing is purchased with the Line of Distinction listing, the monthly rate for the Line of Distinction listing is discounted. The Line of Distinction listing is not available with a Family Space listing.

11.1.6 The Line of Distinction information only appears in the printed directory. This information is not available to Directory Assistance operators.

11.1.7 When a customer requests more than 34 characters of information, additional Line of Distinction listings may be purchased. If the customer requests separate lines consisting of less than 34 characters, the Line of Distinction charge applies to each line. The customer may purchase a maximum of eight (8) Line of Distinction listings associated with any one alphabetical listing.

SUBURBAN SERVICE {1}{2}

1. Rates

The rates for suburban service and the area within which the service is offered, are as specified in the Local Exchange Tariff. In no case will new contracts for suburban service be accepted for less than three main telephones per line or the equivalent rate thereof.

2. New Construction

The construction of new suburban service lines or the extensions of existing lines will be provided by SWBT in accordance with the provisions set forth in the "Construction Charges" section of this tariff.

3. SWBT Rights

SWBT reserves the right to connect business and residence telephones to the same line. No keys for the purpose of cutting off all or a portion of the lines from the office are permitted except in the case of extension telephones, where a key may be provided for disconnecting it from the main telephone.

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{1} Subsequent compliance tariff filings will be made as necessary to implement the provisions of the stipulation as authorized by the Commission's Order in Docket No. 8585.

{2} Upon the elimination of party-line service from an exchange, as specified in the Final Order in Docket No. 8585, suburban 4-party service will no longer be offered in that exchange.

PAY TELEPHONE EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE

4. CALL SCREENING AND SERVICES - (Cont'd)

4.3 Central Office Call Blocking

4.3.1 Local and "1+" call blocking provides central office blocking of all local calls (7 digit) and direct dialed toll calls from coinless telephones. However, a uniform access code 950-XXXX assigned to a carrier for its international communications is not blocked but is routed to that carrier. The calls blocked include, but are not limited to, "1+", "10XXX+1", "10XXX+011", "101XXXX+1" and "101XXXX+011" type calls. This service is offered in serving offices where facilities exist.

4.3.2 International Direct Dialed (IDD) call blocking is an optional service arrangement which provides central office blocking of direct dialed international calls ("011", "10XXX+011" and "101XXXX+011") from coin operated telephones to telephone numbers outside the North American Dialing Plan. This service is offered in serving offices where facilities exist.

Customers who elect not to subscribe to IDD call blocking shall be responsible for the payment of all charges associated with IDD calls and shall indemnify and hold Southwestern Bell Telephone Company harmless from any and all loss and expense occasioned by fraudulent international calls which may be placed from the PTEAS access line.

4.4 Answer Supervision - Line Side

Answer supervision-Line Side provides "off-hook" supervisory signals to customer premises equipment. These signals originate from the "called" party's serving (terminating) central office to a line interface at the "calling" party's serving (originating) central office. This feature provides the signal that allows billing to begin. This feature is not compatible with the Call Waiting, Speed Calling and Three-Way Calling features when provided Selective Class of Call Screening.¹

4.5 SmartCoinSM

SmartCoinSM service is offered, at the customer's option, where the necessary facilities are available. SmartCoinSM access lines may be provided as either two-way or one-way originating only access lines. With the exception of Dial Tone First and Answer Supervision Line Side, the services included on SmartCoinSM Access Lines apply only on local and intraLATA toll calls that are handled by the Telephone Company.

DEER PARK EMERGENCY NETWORK SERVICE

2. Rules and Regulations

- 2.1 Deer Park Emergency Network Service (ENS) is available only to those organizations and individuals with a bona fide need to respond to and manage emergency situations. An application for service must be submitted to the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) for the location where the service is to be provided. The application will be forwarded by the appropriate LEPC to the Deer Park Local Emergency Planning Committee (Deer Park) for final review and approval. Deer Park will then forward the request to SWBT for implementation. In unusual circumstances, and at Deer Park's discretion, an application for service may be submitted directly to Deer Park. In no case will SWBT accept service applications directly.
- 2.2 The tariff monthly rates, service connections, moves and changes, installation charges and service establishment charges specified in the tariffs of SWBT will apply for all services and equipment where appropriate. A Special Installation Charge will apply to all customers ordering ENS. The Special Installation Charge as set forth in paragraph 6 is applicable for and in addition to any existing nonrecurring charges for any other SWBT tariff service.
- 2.3 This is a limited scope service offering and will be available only in those serving central offices as listed in paragraph 1.4, except as otherwise provided under paragraph 1.5.
- 2.4 Sufficient securable floor space and the necessary power wiring, power outlets, commercial power and conduit for the operation of tariff services are furnished by the customer who assumes all responsibility for the safe condition of such floor space, wiring, outlets, power and conduit.
- 2.5 Directory listings are not provided with this service. (D)

- 2.6 Special Service Arrangements consist of modifications of standard tariffed services and as provided in Section 33 of this tariff. Special Service Arrangements will be furnished, when practicable, by SWBT at charges equivalent to the cost of providing such arrangements if in connection with and not detrimental to any of the services furnished under SWBT tariffs.
- 2.7 Temporary suspension of service is not provided for any part of ENS.
- 2.8 The rates for ENS do not include, and SWBT does not undertake, inspection or constant monitoring to discover errors, defects, and malfunctions of the service. The customer has the responsibility to report all errors, defects, and malfunctions in the service to SWBT.
- 2.9 The Deer Park LEPC may assign its coordination and approval duties to a successor entity. However, SWBT reserves the right, upon notice of good cause to the successor entity, to discontinue Emergency Network Service.
- 2.10 ENS shall not be shared or jointly used and resale is prohibited.
